

INFORMATION FOR PERSONS USING CONTACT FORM AVAILABLE AT COMAPANY (MOSTVA SP. Z O.O. IN CIEMNO GNOJNA, POLAND) WEBPAGE (PERSONAL DATA)

Pursuant to the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (GDPR) we inform that:

1. 3. Your personal data will be processed in order to resolve your matter and to reply to your message.
4. Your personal data will be processed in accordance with Article 6 paragraph 1 point (f) of GDPR – which means that processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by MOSTVA sp. z o.o.: resolving your matter.
5. Providing by you your personal data is voluntary, however it is necessary for replying to your message sent by the contact form. Therefore, it may be impossible to reply to your message if you fail to provide such data.
6. The recipients of your personal data: e-mail hosting services provider, providers of legal and consulting services.
7. Your personal data will not be transferred to a third country or international organization.
8. Your personal data will be stored by MOSTVA sp. z o.o. for the time necessary to reply to your message.
9. You have the right to request:
 - a. access to your personal data,
 - b. rectification of your personal data,
 - c. erasure of your personal data,
 - d. restriction of processing your personal data,
 - e. your personal data portability,
 - f. to object processing your personal data.
10. You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority – the President of the Data Protection Office.
11. There will be no automated decision-making, including profiling, as regards to your personal data.
